

Trustees Report for 12/13/2016 Council Meeting

I am traveling this week, so here is my abbreviated report.

* The Sanctuary upgrade plans are on hold until Bill Sabin recovers from his surgery. He is recovering well and we wish him a fast recovery. He is working on the Sanctuary rendering for the congregation to review.

*The Tot Spot facility project are complete. I suggest we develop a method to capture use of the Tot Spot capturing daily use including number of children, parents, and what church activities the parents attended. This quantifies the use and helps us develop growth of the program.

*ARC construction is progressing, but slow. Some subcontractors are working at a slow pace than anticipated. The completions according to Bob Baker looks to be mid-April possibly May.

*Trenching will begin in the parking lot next month. (This was originally scheduled in Sept. but the contractor changed the schedule to allow for more parking) Once the trenching begins, the parking will be reduced by 20 spaces. This is mostly due to installations of islands for light standards.

*The BOT has successfully negotiated the 2017 contract for continued cleaning service from our long time and appreciated janitor, Ed.
