Youth and Parents,

I'm excited to get to continue this tradition of going down to Disneyland! The following information will help you decide if this trip is for you/your child and prepare you for a fun trip!

Who: Middle school and high school youth

Where: We'll be staying at Anaheim UMC, about a 10 minute drive from the parks.

When: We'll leave Alamo on February 15 and get back on the 18th

Cost: \$350/person if you need a ticket, \$130/person if you have your own season passes

Registration: Permission slips and payment are both due by January 26

Itinerary:

Friday, 2/15

1:00pm—Meet at SRVUMC

1:30pm—Leave the church, we'll stop for dinner along the way

10:00pm—Arrive in Anaheim

11:00pm—Lights out

Saturday and Sunday, 2/16-17

7:00am—Wake up, eat breakfast, get ready for the day

7:45am—Head to the park (opens at 8am)

10:00pm—Leave the park after the fireworks show

*on Sunday we'll leave the park at 9:30

10:30pm—Devotion time

11:00pm—Lights out

Monday, 2/18

7:00am—Wake up, eat breakfast, pack

8:00am—Leave Anaheim no later than 8am, we'll stop for lunch on the way
back

About 4:00pm we'll arrive back in Alamo

This schedule isn't definite and is subject to change

Cost: The trip costs \$330 per person. The 2 day park-hopper tickets cost \$215 each, the additional, \$115 covers the estimated cost of van rentals, gas, breakfast, snacks and lodging.

Food: We will provide your child with breakfast each day and a snack to bring with them to the park, this leaves 6 meals that they will need to have money for (dinner on the way up, lunch and dinner in the parks, and lunch on the way back down). I recommend your child bringing at least \$100 for food expenses. If your child does not have adequate money for food, we have the supplies for them to bring a sack lunch and dinner for each day. If this is the case, please let me know ahead of time so I can plan accordingly.

Packing List:

1. Clothes (it will be cold and there's a chance of rain, be sure to check the weather and plan accordingly!)
2. A purse or small backpack
3. Re-usable water bottle
4. Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
5. A sleeping bag and pillow
6. Money for food and souvenirs
7. Phones and phone chargers
8. A Bible

Lodging: We will most likely be staying at Anaheim UMC. I've been told the youth group has stayed there before and it was a good experience. They only have 1 shower for use and they told me there's a chance we might not have access to it, so I recommend showering before we leave on Friday and getting comfortable with the idea that you probably won't shower again until you get back. Please bring some deodorant.

Chaperones: Want to chaperone? Know someone who's looking to get involved with the youth? Let me know! We'll need 3 more chaperones in addition to myself who are willing to drive up and back. We will be renting either a 15-passenger van or a couple 7-passenger minivans, but we'll still need a couple more cars to help seat the rest of the youth and carry luggage.

Registration Deadline: The payment of \$330 and the permission slip form (found on the next page) must both be in to me by Saturday **January 26, 2019** if you want to go on this trip. They will not be accepted any later than that as I will be buying the tickets the next day, Sunday the 27th.

If for whatever reason your child is unable to go on the trip, you will be able to get your money back up until January 27th when I buy the tickets.
